ReferralNet Secure Messaging Now Available for HealthKit Customers

- *ReferralNet expands the market for secure messaging with over 15,000 HealthKit customers*

Following Global Health's strategic partnership with the Australian Psychological Society (APS) announced on 17 May 2016, the parties moved to implement ReferralNet within the HealthKit application to enable HealthKit users to send and receive correspondence in compliance with Australian national standards for Secure Message Delivery.

HealthKit has one of the largest networks of practitioners in Australia with customers ranging from GPs and medical specialists to multiple allied health specialties including more than 4,000 in the mental health profession. HealthKit users are one of the largest networks within the APS membership base.

"The Australian Digital Health Authority (ADHA) has a renewed focus on secure messaging as a foundation towards moving to a paperless health world. The Royal Australian College of General Practice says a 'national priority' now exists for the healthcare sector to move away from paper-based healthcare communication systems towards electronic systems, calling for the final chapter to be closed on the era of the letter and the fax machine within the next three years.

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“Aside from the obvious productivity gains to practices through reduced paper handling and data re-keying, the need for digital data to seamlessly flow across healthcare is recognised as essential for improving patient safety and patient outcomes.

“This collaboration with HealthKit significantly increases the number of healthcare providers now enabled for Secure Message Delivery (SMD) particularly across allied health practitioners.”

An initial cohort of HealthKit customers will be enabled with ReferralNet Secure Messaging capability as early adopters prior to full availability across the HealthKit customer base.
