

Western Australia's Mental Health Commission selects MasterCare

Global Health's MasterCare platform will enable the WA Mental Health Commission to meet the key State and Federal reporting requirements for Alcohol and Other Drug Treatment Services. With the solution becoming WA MHC's core EMR solution for managing the treatment of clients and enabling users to connect to critical infrastructure such as the Government's MyHealthRecord and comply with other Digital Health initiatives such as Secure Messaging and ePrescribing.

MasterCare has emerged as the market leading EMR for Australian Community Health organisations in recent years, with the WA MHC join being the latest of several key accounts to select MasterCare EMR in 2020.

The Project will see the delivery of a module in MasterCare that will collect and report the WA MHC's data set for drug and alcohol services, which extends an already comprehensive list of programs now natively supported in the application. This list includes major programs such as the

PMHC, AOD NMDS, CH, VINAH, HACC and NDIS.
